The PTA will again be hosting a movie night to coincide with World Book day on the 3rd March. On this day we encourage all children to come to school dressed as a character from their favourite books.

Doors will open for movie night at 6pm and movies will start at 6.15 sharp. Children can be collected from 7.45pm. Arrangements are as follows-

When arriving they pay £1 at the door and will be taken to the movie of their choice by staff. On the night, parents can park in the parish car park. P1-3 children should enter through the P2/3 playground entrance. P4-7 should line up at the back playground and will enter at the P4 door. The back gate will also be open to facilitate ease of access. Children will be supervised in the building by teachers and PTA members and will be able to buy a treat pack at the cost of £1. At the end of the evening, children should be collected from the same doors they came in. Please be patient with us during collection but we must ensure that each child is delivered safely to their adult as it will be dark. Please note that all children from P1-P7 **MUST** be collected by an adult.

REMINDER: The PTA is planning to host a school talent show in May. Children can begin thinking about their acts and Mrs McCoy will run an after schools club to help children to practice. We hope as many children as possible will be able to participate as St. Joseph's does indeed have talent! The next meeting of the PTA is on Tuesday 1st March at 6pm in school. Well done to Leah from P6 who took part in a festival and scored 82 out of a possible 90 in the singing section. Great job Leah!


Well done to Roisin, Eve, Holly, Katie and Kaya from P6 who completed their
